

Policies & Procedures: Woodcroft Rec

Weather Alerts:

There are three methods for weather updates, 1) Sign-up to receive text alerts for field closure by clicking [here](#), select "W" for Woodcroft, 2) Check the Triangle United [website](#) for weather updates, and 3) Call our weather line at 919-942-2036

Registration:

To guarantee your child's participation in the upcoming soccer season, registration must be completed *and paid for*, online through our Demosphere TeamNet portal prior to the registration window closing. If either or both of the parents of the child are interested or willing to volunteer to coach their child's team, they can volunteer during the registration process.

Late registration:

There will be a \$15 late fee for registrations being completed after the registration window has closed. The primary deciding factor for team placement of a late registration will be roster size. Any requests made will be considered secondarily to roster sizes. A returning player may not be placed on their team from the Fall and will incur the \$10 uniform fee if placed on a new team, requiring an additional jersey for the soccer season.

Team placement:

Fall. Team placement is based off of the date of registration. We function in a first-come-first-serve style. The later you register, the less chance you have of being placed on your requested team. Team placement is determined in the following order: 1) day requested, 2) time requested, 3) coach requested, and 4) teammate requested. Any request to switch teams must be sent to the Program Director within 48 hours of the team placements being announced. This is due to the timing of the first uniform order. Any request for a team switch sent more than 48 hours after team placements have been announced may be denied, or an additional \$10 charge may be applied if a second uniform order is required due to the late switch request.

Spring. Team placement is determined in the following order: 1) returning players are automatically placed on their team from the Fall season. If a returning player desires to switch teams, they must send in a request to the Woodcroft [Director](#) within 24 hours of submitting their registration. Additionally, there is a \$10 (uniform) charge to switch teams between the Fall and Spring seasons. Requests made after registration closes are likely to be rejected. 2) day requested, 3) time requested, 4) coach requested, and 5) teammate requested. Any request to switch teams must be sent to the Program Director within 48 hours of the team placements being announced. This is due to the timing of the first uniform order. Any request for a team switch sent more than 48 hours after team placements have been announced may be denied, or

an additional \$10 charge may be applied if a second uniform order is required due to the late switch request.

Uniforms:

There will be 3 uniform orders made per season. The first uniform order will be made 72 hours after team placements have been announced. The second uniform order will be made 1 week prior to the first game. The third (and final) uniform order will be made following the first official game of the season. Spring Season: returning players from the Fall are expected to wear their Fall uniforms for the entire soccer year which runs from Fall to Spring. Only new players in the Spring will receive a uniform, unless a request is sent to the [Director](#) within 48 hours of the team placement announcement. A returning player requesting a new uniform in the Spring season will cost \$10.

Cost:

KickStart Program (Ages 4-and-under)

\$50/season. Cost covers weekly 1-hour sessions, and 1 jersey.

5U/6U Coed (Ages 5 and 6)

\$90/season. Cost covers weekly 1-hour practice, weekend games, and 1 game uniform (jersey, shorts, and socks).

Returning player discount (*Spring season only*): A \$10 discount will be given to all players who are returning from the Fall season, remain on their team from the fall season, and do not require a new uniform.

8U-15U Coed (Ages 7-15)

\$100/season. Cost covers weekly 1-hour practice, weekend games, and 1 game uniform (jersey, shorts, and socks).

Returning player discount (*Spring season only*): A \$10 discount will be given to all players who are returning from the Fall season, remain on their team from the fall season, and do not require a new uniform.

8U-12U Girls (Ages 7-12)

\$100/season. Cost covers weekly 1-hour practice, weekend games, and 1 game uniform (jersey, shorts, and socks) for new players only.

Refunds:

Any player who requires a refund will receive a partial refund due to a withheld administrative fee of \$20.

Woodcroft Swim & Tennis Courts Rules and Regulations

Triangle United players, parents and staff are guests while using the Woodcroft Swim and Tennis Club (WSTC) parking lot and community fields. Please obey the following rules because failure to do so can result in the parking and playing fields to be pulled from us.

1. Do not use the WSTC bathrooms, portable toilets will be provided for Triangle United use.
2. When entering the fields from the parking lot please use the access ramp or foot paths. **We are not to use the deck as the player's cleats will cause damage to the wood.**
3. All trash is to be taken from the fields, please do not use the WSTC trash receptacles or dumpster located in the parking lot. Treat the facility as a "carry in, carry out" facility.
4. Parking for Triangle United activities is only permitted during regularly scheduled practices and games. Please do not use the parking lot during any other hours.
5. Improperly parked cars (i.e.: those not in a parking space such as those that park in the grassy areas in the lot) will be towed at the owner's expense.
6. Please drive slowly through the neighborhood and parking lot to keep all playing children safe.
7. All lost and found items should be given to the coaches or managers on duty. Should you lose anything at the fields please email woodcroftsoccer@triangleunited.org for assistance.

Additional Parking Rules:

- *Please park in only designated spaces in the upper two parking lots at the WSTC
- *No parking is allowed where there are solid yellow lines or along the access road to the boat storage
- *No parking in the marked spaces that are reserved for the businesses that share the parking lot
- *In the event the parking lot is full, **DO NOT PARK ON THE SHOULDERS OF WOODCROFT PARKWAY!** This is a safety issue as well as **ILLEGAL**. You may want to park at the Woodcroft shopping center, or on Sandstone Ridge Drive or Winterberry Dr. If parking along Sandstone Ridge or Winterberry, please respect the homeowners (i.e.: do not block private driveways, block streets, or park on their lawns). Illegally parked cars will be ticketed by Durham Police or towed at the owner's expense.
- *If we are found in violation of the parking guidelines on three separate occasions, we will be fined each time and the program will be terminated following the third offense.
- *We will not issue refunds if the program is terminated due to repeated violation of the above rules and guidelines**
